Accommodation	Ilia State University will assist in finding affordable housing options for apartments in Tbilisi, close to the university campus. The prices for a furnished studio in a central area range from 400 to 500EUR, while the prices for a shared apartment in a normal/peripheral area range from 300 to 400EUR per month.
Cost of Living	<p>Local currency in Georgia is Georgian Lari (GEL).
